Surrounded on three sides by water, Scotland has over 6,000 miles of coastline and 30,000 lochs, making it a joy for any nautically-inclined visitors and landlubbers alike.

A seemingly never-ending resource, exploring this country by water is a fantastic idea. Loch Ness alone contains more water than all the lakes in England and Wales combined. Whitesandy beaches, jaw-dropping sea cliffs, stunning vistas and inlets perfect for picnics await.
